

Dancin' On Main's Covid-19 Requirements and Procedures

Cleaning/Disinfecting and Air Quality

All surfaces that are touched (ballet barres, tumbling mats, etc.) will be disinfected after every class. Floors and bathroom will be cleaned at the end of each day or before the first class the following day. New recommended furnace/air conditioner filters are being used and changed once a month. An air purifier cooling unit is also used.

Families

If there is any sign of fever or other symptoms the student or any other household member has, please keep the student home. Families will be allowed back in the waiting room starting in August, but space is limited, so if it looks full when you arrive, please consider waiting outside or in your car. Anyone over the age of 12 who is not vaccinated will be required to wear a mask if staying inside the studio.

Class Check In/Out

Some classes will have time between each class, but some do not due to schedule limits. I ask that no one arrive to class too early, and no one be late to pick up the students. Please encourage your students to quickly pack up and get shoes on so the next class can get started. Use of hand sanitizer or washing hands upon arrival to class and before they leave the studio after class will still be encouraged.

Class Procedures

Children's classes will have no more than 9 - 12 students, depending on age. We will still use marked spots on the floor to remain socially distant. We will play some games to help students stay on/near their spots. For Tumbling classes, all warm-ups and waiting to take turns will be done on their assigned spots on the floor unless class size allows for proper spacing on the mats. Please discourage your students from hugging, climbing on or touching each other in general (unless it is part of choreography with hand sanitizer used). There will be one or two assistant teachers for all Wednesday and Saturday classes to help the younger students follow these procedures. All dance teachers and assistants are fully vaccinated. They must also be symptom free and follow the same hand sanitizing/washing procedures.

Food/Drink

Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles labeled with their name. The water cooler may now be used by all. Food will only be allowed in the back room. Please no nuts or peanut butter in case of allergies.

Masks

Face masks are optional for students. This may change depending on CDC and State recommendations and requirements. Family members over the age of 12 who are not fully vaccinated are required to wear a mask inside of the studio if waiting in the back room.
